Each year, Scouts from the Alamo Area Council raise money to fund their Scouting programs through the annual camp card sale program.

This year, Camp Cards will begin on March 1st and continue until May 22nd. During this period Scouts will sell the \$5.00 card and keep 50 percent commission on every card to help fund their Scouting adventures.

With 100% of the proceeds staying local, the purpose of this annual sale is to help Scouts earn funds for their yearly activities and provide program and camping opportunities to over 18,000 youth and 6,500 volunteer adults in the Council's 13 county area.
