# National Youth Leadership Training



## WHY

Should youth leaders attend National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT)?

The NYLT course presents what a leader must **BE**, what a leader must **KNOW** and what a leader must **DO**, by applying modern leadership and team development theories in a linked-troop environment.

Participants camp, work, play and learn - living a month in the life of a model troop/ship/crew condensed into an intense week long course. They experience the stages of team development, practice from a "toolbox" of leadership skills and learn that leadership requires vision, goals, and planning.

Participants learn how to be a leading influence in their own unit; discovering resources, methods, games and new skills to make unit meetings, treks and other activities more exciting and worthwhile. They also develop skills that help them emerge as leaders outside their units - at school and in the community.

## NYLT Goals

- To develop a youth's confidence and knowledge in leading their unit's program.
- To gain working understanding of the resources, skills and methods needed to undertake further leadership responsibility
- To share ideas and learn from the experiences of other youth from troops/teams/crews across the Alamo Area Council.
- To support adult leaders in training youth leaders.
- To reinforce a youth's relationship with his unit leader and other adult leaders.
- To experience Scouting at its very best.

## Who may attend?

Qualified candidates will meet the following criteria...

- Must be a registered member of a Scouting unit.
- Must have a current, 2019 version, BSA Health and Medical Record form parts A, B, and C.
- Must be a First Class Scout and have completed the Introduction to Leadership Skills for Troops (ILST) course.
- Scouts BSA members (male and female) must be at least 13.
- Venturers and Sea Scouts (male and female) must be at least 14, or 13 and have completed eighth grade, and fall within the maximum age allowance for their program. Must have completed ILS for Crews or Ships.
- Have a unit leader recommendation.

Note: To enable broad council participation and the best youth experience, the number of participants from each unit is limited to 4. Others will be held on a waitlist to be added if spots are available.
