

Alamo Area Council Missions Historical Trail

Sponsored by the Aina Topa Hutsi Lodge

Requirements:

1. Hikers must be at least 7 years of age at the time the hike is taken and meet all requirements on the trail.
2. Scouts must wear the correct Scout uniform while on the trail. Scout shirt and shorts are recommended during the summer months. Other groups should have some article that will identify them as a member of that group while on the trail.
3. Each hiker must hike the entire length of the trail, visit all historical sites, and participate in programs and activities scheduled for the group.
4. Any hiker disregarding the rules and requirements of the trail may result in the entire group being disqualified from receiving patches.
5. All groups must stay together while on the hike. Large groups may divide into smaller segments, but each segment must have 2 deep adult leadership.
6. Each hiker should help look for answers to the "On The Trail" quiz and sign their name on it. Group leaders will collect the quiz and fees and submit them along with the application form to the Alamo Area Council. Patches will only be sold upon presentation of the proper forms signed by the designated authority and are limited to one patch per hiker.
7. Review the points of the Scout Law that deal with courtesy, obedience, and reverence. Remember that the missions are still used for religious services.
